4. Receiving file no. (charges Rs. 20000)
5. Submit files with all documents and revised form to Canada high commission (New Delhi) (Charges Rs. 30000)
6. Receiving file number (Charges CAD 490 - Adults + Rs. 20000)
7. Medical / Interview
8. Grant / Refusal of Immigration visa
