Advantages of skilled Migration

Pass mark in points test = 100(min) and 140 points for Pool Entries.

IELTS is valid for – 2 years (At the time of ‘invitation to apply’ form EOI).

Almost any skill can qualify with the extensive list in Long Term Skill Shortage List.

No ‘minimum threshold’ employment requirement – people without work experience also qualify for migration, though experience will fetch extra points.

Very low fee for lodging EOI. - ONLY e-lodgment.
